








Gothic Horror in the 18th Century








Early 20th Century Pulp Fiction

What is Horror?

The goal of horror is to inspire fear. Horror manipulates our deep-rooted anxieties and brings them vividly to life on the page. These fears could be material -- clowns, wolves, vampires -- or they could be intangible, like solitude poverty, and failure. Escalating tension pits an everyman against his own mind in a clash that is often more psychological than physical.

What happens in a Horror novel?

Horror tales often begin in a fairly normal world, suddenly and disastrously invaded by monsters, and lead to a horrific climax. Many layer tension upon tension as the story builds toward a showdown with a psychological and/or corporeal tormenter, possibly with a shocking twist. In all horror stories, expect an uneasy atmosphere. Intensified by graphic violence, strong language, and explicit sex, these novels explore the dark side of human nature

Why do people like to read Horror?

They expect to be scared and are drawn to stories that hurtle them down dark roads at a fast clip. Horror allows readers to face their worst fears in a safe environment. Horror answers the "What if?" question by giving readers a place to indulge, rather than deny, the primal itch to go down those dark basement steps, to confront what is just past the line of vision. Fans of horror savor the genre's ability to follow temptation and take pleasure in terror

family during the Great Recession. Eight-year-old Merry witnesses her unemployed father's increasing focus on religion with unease. Merry's older sister, Marjorie, is experiencing escalating psychotic breaks, leading John to sign the family up for a reality TV show that would center around Marjorie's exorcism -- and give them some much-needed money.
